## 1. Disciple Making Movement ( DMM )

Our work is still limited to 3 provinces for now, with the plan of expansion as God leads. In **G Kivu**), we have a friend who shares with us the same heart and who is under our leadership and reaching and Disciple our country. He is called Etienne: ( Pictured),

**January, Etienne** baptized 2 people – girl and boy from the same family accepted Jesus and re The plan is to continue teaching them so that they may do the same thing. We are In contact with Etienne and support him from Uvira by sending books and when we have evangelists and church planter here, we invite him.

Remy moves on motorcycle to different areas for Evangelism and simple church planting where  
churches in villages

He works with me to mobilize the pastors in this region to involve their churches in Evangelism  
Discipleship



Whenever our team goes for Missions outside Of Uvira where our base is, this is how we look

In January alone, Remy baptized two Moslems who came to Jesus. Glory to God.

This has been very encouraging for us, and on another hand putting us in a position of being followed by the Moslem guy, but we have not seen anything yet up to now. We also understand that this is our mandate, working with Ezekiel's prophecies: "... the last days shall bring back the children to their fathers...", and I believe that, this is what the Lord is doing now in our area because it is unbelievable.
