In this village alone, they got 22 souls for Jesus and ready to be baptized next week. This is revival, as in this village there are so many local alcohol being sold there, few denominational churches.

Then they went to Baraka, where they had to cross over using the boat, because it rained a lot and the bridge flooded.



In some of the areas, transport can be very much challenging but as Paul said: Rom. 8: 31-32 "... what will separate us from the Love of God? ..."



What was interesting in this particular area was that: "we need to have our churches here, because since we are here, we have not yet seen churches doing what you are doing (evangelism – presenting Jesus and his Grace, not judging them)," said the local people.

These are alcohol and drug addict people; left away of the church to save themselves, and no one approaches them, but just judging them.

Baptisms:

Each two weeks we are having baptism in one of the location we are working in, for example in Uvira, This month we have baptized 13 people – Praise the Lord.



Radio Project and solar system:

we didn't want to keep quiet on the progress of solar system establishment in our radio.

Here is the battery of 200 Amph, with an inverter of 1200 VA. we are still waiting for another battery of Amph, and solar panel that we sent from Hong Kong, as soon as they are here we can start putting the welding area where we are going to pose on the panel and then finish the installation of the system.



Prayer request:

1. **Travel facilitation need:** this has been a very big burden on the church, as we have a vision for construction, yet a lot of money is being invested in this. Please for us to have 1 motorbike (USD 1500), that would be taking our Evangelists and Missionaries to the field for the harvest. With this we can be only working on having the fuel which is USD 1.5 per liter.
2. In the near future we are planning to have Uvira evangelistic training coming from different churches, to teach them e-cube approach and the need for soul winning.
